Workshop on "Paanch Sutras" of Poshan Abhiyaan - 28th February, 2020



A host of activities were conducted for Poshan Pakhwada. As part of the "Paanch Sutras" of Poshan Abhiyaan, a workshop was organized in collaboration with Department of Community Medicine and School of Public Health, PGIMER and Vendor's Cell, Municipal Corporation Chandigarh for mainstreaming street vendors' welfare through integrated training enterprise of its Municipal Corporation with special focus on street food hygiene. More than 50 students, street vendors, mess and canteen workers attended the workshop.



Healthy millets recipe competition held to observe "Year of Millets" - 26th February, 2020

To promote 'Self- Reliance through Health and Entrepreneurship' and to observe the "Year of Millets", in collaboration with Regional Centre for Entrepreneurship Development (RCED), a healthy millet recipe competition on behalf of the National Institute of Naturopathy, Pune, Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India was organized. More than 30 post graduate and under graduate students participated in the competition. Sh. SK Mehta from Food Processing Institute, Food and Nutrition Board and Principal, Prof. Sudha Katyal were the esteemed judges for the event. A wide range of recipes ranging from jowar pockets to ragi dhokla and ragi chocolate lava cake were prepared by the students. Prizes were awarded for best recipes and best innovation.









Demonstration on use of healthy millets recipes - 12th March, 2020

Demonstration cum Display of healthy millet recipes were prepared by the students of MSc Foods and Nutrition. The recipes included the substitution of our commonly consumed grains such as wheat, rice, maize with millets such as Jowar,











Bajra and Ragi. The students advocated the use of Bajra for its fiber content and also iron. Ragi can be used as a healthy vegetarian option for calcium rich recipes. Breakfast recipes ranged from Ragi Pancakes to Cheelas to Bajra Upma and Stuffed Jowar Paranthas were prepared and displayed by the students on the college campus.

Sensitization on role of men in promoting good nutrition - 13th March, 2020

As part of the ongoing Poshan Pakhwada, the final year students of B.Sc Dietitics of Government Home Science College, prepared and displayed nutritional aids on anemia, balanced diet and importance of Millets in the campus. The focus/target group comprised of males from teaching, non teaching, office and support staff of the college. They were sensitized on the importance and role of men in promoting good nutrition at home. Substitution of Millets with commonly consumed grains was also advocated and encouraged in the daily diet for their health benefits.











Awareness generation on hygiene practices during Covid-19 and use of millets in weaning foods - 15th March, 2020

The B.Sc. students of Home Science College prepared and displayed weaning foods for growing infants using millets as the main ingredients. Millets help increase the soluble fiber, as well as iron and calcium content of the diet. Awareness was also generated for the precautions to be maintained and hygiene practices to be observed during this time to prevent the spread of Corona virus. Emphasis was made on the importance of maintaining hygiene during this stressful period as well as ensuring good nutrition to help build up a strong immunity and stay healthy.

Special efforts were made by the college for reusing and recycling waste materials. The practice of segregation of dry and wet waste leads to encouragement of green campus in the institution. Dry waste compost is used to prepare compost and manure by digging pits near U.G and P.G hostels. This compost and manure is utilized in college green lawns. In 2019, the college also purchased a composting machine for waste management under M & S plan worth Rs. 5.85 lacs. In the composting machine kitchen garbage waste can be converted





to manure for plants. The de gradable items can be simply decomposed safely and hygienically in a machine. Blue and green dustbins were also placed in hostels and college campus for collection of dry and wet garbage separately. The college is successfully converting waste into manure.
