Notification

New Delhi, 29th March, 2022

G.S.R. 230(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Conditions of Service of Union Territory of Chandigarh Employee Rules, 1992, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the conditions of service of persons appointed to the services and posts under the administrative control of the Administrator of the Union Territory of Chandigarh, namely :—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the Union Territory of Chandigarh Employees (Conditions of Service) Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force on the 1st of April 2022.

2. **Conditions of Service of persons appointed to the services and posts under the administrative control of Administrator.**—(1) The conditions of service of persons appointed to the services and posts,—

(i) in Group 'A', Group 'B' and Group 'C' under the administrative control of the Administrator of the Union Territory of Chandigarh shall, subject to any other provision made by the President in this behalf, be the same as the conditions of service of the persons appointed to corresponding services and posts in Central Civil Services of the Government of India and shall be governed by the same rules and orders as are applicable to the latter category of persons;

(ii) in Group 'D' under the administrative control of the Administrator of the Union Territory of Chandigarh shall, subject to any other provision made by the President in this behalf, be the same as the conditions of the service of the persons appointed to the corresponding Group C posts in Central Civil Services of the Government of India and shall be governed by the same rules and orders as are applicable to the latter category of persons :

Provided that in case of persons appointed to the services and posts under the administrative control of the Administrator of the Union Territory of Chandigarh, who were earlier drawing scales of pay at the rates admissible to the corresponding categories of employees of the Government of Punjab, it shall be competent for the Administrator to revise their scales of pay from time to time so as to bring them at par with the scales of pay which may be sanctioned by the Government of India from time to time to the corresponding categories of its employees :

Provided further that the conditions of service including the pay scales in respect of a teaching faculty of,—

(i) a Technical University or Institution, which is governed by the All India Council for Technical Education or Council of Architecture; and

(ii) a Higher Educational University or Institutions, which is governed by the University Grants Commission,

vide regulations as made by such Councils or Commission, as the case may be, under any law for the time being in force as applicable, shall be such as specified in the said regulations.

(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-rule (1), a person appointed to the services and posts under the administrative control of the Administrator of the Union Territory of Chandigarh shall be subject to transfer from one Department to another Department so long as such transfer does not adversely affect the pay and allowances, seniority or promotion and all other financial benefits as applicable to such persons.

सा.सू.नि. 230(अ)—राष्ट्रपति, संविधान के अनुच्छेद 309 द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए, और चंडीगढ़ संघ राज्य क्षेत्र कर्मचारी सेवा शर्त नियम, 1992 के अधिकरण में, उन बातों को विचार किये ऐसे अधिकरण के पूर्व किए गए हैं या करने का तोष किया गया है, चंडीगढ़ संघ राज्य क्षेत्र के प्रशासक के प्रशासनिक नियंत्रणाधीन सेवाओं और पदों पर नियुक्त व्यक्तियों की सेवा शर्तों को विनियमित करने के लिए निम्नलिखित नियम बनाते हैं अर्थात् :—

1. संक्षिप्त नाम तथा प्रारंभ.—(1) इन नियमों का संक्षिप्त नाम चंडीगढ़ संघ राज्य क्षेत्र कर्मचारी (सेवा शर्त) नियम, 2022 है।
(2) ये दिनांक 01.04.2022 को प्रवृत्त होंगे।

2. प्रशासक के प्रशासनिक नियंत्रणाधीन सेवाओं और पदों पर नियुक्त व्यक्तियों की सेवा शर्तें—

(1) सेवाओं और पदों पर नियुक्त व्यक्तियों की सेवा शर्तें,—

(i) चंडीगढ़ संघ राज्य क्षेत्र के प्रशासक के प्रशासनिक नियंत्रणाधीन समूह 'क', समूह 'ख' तथा समूह 'ग' में, इस निमित्त राष्ट्रपति द्वारा बनाये गए किसी अन्य उपबंध के अध्याधीन, यही होंगी जो भारत सरकार की केंद्रीय सिविल सेवाओं की तत्सम सेवाओं और पदों पर नियुक्त व्यक्तियों की सेवा शर्तें होती हैं और उन्हीं नियमों और आवेदों जो पश्चात्कथित व्यक्तियों पर लागू होते हैं, द्वारा शासित होंगे ;

(ii) चंडीगढ़ संघ राज्य क्षेत्र के प्रशासक के प्रशासनिक नियंत्रणाधीन समूह 'घ' में, इस निमित्त राष्ट्रपति द्वारा बनाये गए किसी अन्य उपबंध के अध्याधीन, यही होंगी जो भारत सरकार की केंद्रीय सिविल सेवाओं के तत्सम समूह 'ग' पदों पर नियुक्त व्यक्तियों की सेवा शर्तें होती हैं और उन्हीं नियमों और आवेदों द्वारा जो पश्चात्कथित व्यक्तियों पर लागू होते हैं, द्वारा शासित होंगे ;

परंतु यह कि चंडीगढ़ संघ राज्य क्षेत्र के प्रशासक के प्रशासनिक नियंत्रणाधीन सेवाओं और पदों पर नियुक्त ऐसे व्यक्तियों के मामले में, जो पूर्व में पंजाब सरकार के कर्मचारियों की तत्समान श्रेणियों के अनुश्रेय पदों पर वेतनमान आधारित कर रहे थे, प्रशासक उनके वेतनमानों को समय-समय पर पुनरीक्षित करके उनको भारत सरकार द्वारा अपने कर्मचारियों की तत्समान श्रेणियों के लिए समय-समय पर स्वीकृत वेतनमान के बराबर करने के लिए सक्षम होंगे ;

परंतु यह और कि—

(i) किसी तकनीकी विश्वविद्यालय या संस्थान, जो अखिल भारतीय तकनीकी शिक्षा परिषद या वास्तु परिषद द्वारा शासित होता है ; तथा

(ii) किसी उच्चतर शैक्षिक विश्वविद्यालय अथवा संस्थान, जो विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग द्वारा शासित होता है,

के अध्यापन संकाय की बाबत वेतनमान सहित सेवा शर्तें, जो तत्समय प्रवृत्त किसी विधि के अधीन यथा लागू परिषद या आयोग, जैसा भी मान्य हो, द्वारा बनाए गए विनियमों द्वारा बनाई गई हो, उक्त विनियमों में निरिदिष्ट की जाएगी।

(2) उप नियम (1) में अंतर्निहित किसी बात को छोड़ें हुए भी, चंडीगढ़ संघ राज्य क्षेत्र के प्रशासक के प्रशासनिक नियंत्रणाधीन सेवाओं और पदों पर नियुक्त किसी व्यक्ति का एक विभाग से दूसरे विभाग में, जब तक कि ऐसे स्थानांतरण से ऐसे व्यक्तियों को लागू नियमों और शर्तों, ज्येष्ठता या पदोन्नति तथा अन्य वित्तीय लाभ प्रतिकूल रूप से प्रभावित नहीं होते हों, स्थानांतरण के अध्याधीन होंगे।

Subject: Clarification regarding applicability of Central Service Rules

With the notifying of the Union Territory of Chandigarh Employees (Conditions of Service) Rules, 2022, vide Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs' notification No. G.S.R. 230(E) dated 29.03.2022 as republished in Chandigarh e-gazette portal on 30.03.2022, which came into force w.e.f. 01.04.2022, the Conditions of Service of persons appointed to the services and posts, in Group A, B, and C under the Administrative control of the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh shall be same as the conditions of service of the persons appointed to corresponding services and posts in Central Civil Services of the Government of India. Rules/ Guidelines/ Instructions issued by the Govt. of India are applicable to the employees of Chandigarh Administration w.e.f. 01.04.2022.
