America B No.19/1/3-IH(3)-2004/ Chandigarn Administration Home Department Chandigarh, dated the 19.1 3121 All the Administrative Secretaries/ Head of Departments/Offices/Boards/ Corporation in Chandigarh Administration. Policy regarding reservations of seats in admission to B.Ed College and Govt Home Science College, Chandigarh. I am directed to invite attention to this Administration circular lefter No.19/1/3/93-IH(3)-99/11136 dated 9.6.1998 on the subject noted above and to state that the Chandigarn Administration has decided to allocate 60% seats for UT Pool and 40% seats for General Pool/Outside Pool In respect of B.Ed. College and Government Home Science Collage, Chandigarh in stead of 85% seats for UT Pool and 15% seats for General Pool/Outside Pool with effect, from the forth coming session 2004-2005. The other provisions in the existing policy shall remain unchanged. Yours falthfully, Secretary Technical Education, For Home Secretary, Chandigarh Administration.

Subject: -- Policy regarding reservation of seats in edmission to educational/technical/medical institutions under the control of Chandie rh Administration.

I am directed to address you on the subject noted above and to say that in order to bring uniformity in matters regarding admission in all me institutions under the control of Chandigarh Administration and also to clarify the policy more with regard to reservation of seats to remove any ambiguity while implementing the same and further with a view to making such policy handy and available at one place, it has been decided by the Chandigarh Administration to frame the policy for reservation in admissions afresh as under:-

- (1) Except Chandigars medical College, Chandigars, where 85% seats are filled from an ingst the students who pass their qualifying examination from he institutions situated in the Union Territory, Chandigars and 15% seats are filled on All India basis, in other institutions 60% seats of the total sanctioned intake of the institution will be filled up from amongst the students who pass their qualifying examination from schools/Colleges recognised v Chandigars Administration and situated in the Union Territory, Chandigars as a regular student of the said school/college subject to the condition that such students must have studied for two years at Chandigars and have passed one lower qualifying examination from these schools/colleges. These seats will be termed as 'U.T. Pool'. The remaining 40% seats will be filled from amongst the students who pass their qualifying examination from the institutions other than those located in the Union Territory. Chandigars or otherwise; these seats will be termed as 'General Pool'.
 - (2) Reservation in sects for various categories of students in each pool shall be as under: --
 - (a) Reservation for Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes Union Territory Pool.

If the requisite number of students of Scheduled castes community in the Union Territory Pool are not available, the seats will be thrown open to the students belonging to general

category of the said pool. In general pool, if the requisite number of students belonging to S.C./S.T. commity act not available, the reservation will be interchangeable amongst the students of these communities. However, if the seats still remain unfilled from the students belonging to these communities, these will be thrown open amongst the students belonging to the general category of the said pool.

The students belonging to these communities shall be allowed a concession of 5% marks for admission to the courses in which a certain pure stage of minimum marks has been prescribed, if permitted by the rules/regulations of the University/Board, to which he institution is affiliated.

(b) Reservation for dependants of Defence/Para-military personnel etc.

Five percent scats in each pool would be filled from the following categories of students, in order of preferance:--

(i) Sons/daughters/spouse: of defence personnel who are awardees of gallantory decorations of Paramvir/Mahavir/Vir Chakra in person or posthumously.

OR

Sons/daughters/spouses of defence personnel and paramilitary personnel like CRPF. BSF atc. who are killed or are totally incapacitated in action while in service and were wholly dependant on them.

- (ii) Sons/daughters/spouse of defence personnel and paramilitary personnel like CRPF, BSF etc who die while in service and were wholly dependant on them.
- (iii) Sons/daughters/spouses of defence personnel and paramilitary personnel like CMPF, BSF, eet. Incapacitated while in service and ware wholly dependent on them.
- (iv) Sons/daughters/spouses of ex-servicemen (defence and para-military personnel like CRPF, BSF etc.) who are wholly dependent on them.
- (v) Sons/daughters/spouses of serving defence and paramilitary personnel like CRPF, BSF, etc. who are wholly dependent on them.

(c) Reservation for physically handicapped

One per-cent/seats in each pool would be filled from amongst the physically handicapped candidates. The physically handicapped student will be furnish a medical certificate issued by the Principal Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon of Chandigarh or his concerned district, indicating percentage of disability whether he/she is otherwise able to carry on the studies and perform the duties in the respective course, name of the disease causing handicap, whether handicap is temporary or permanent, whether handicap is progressive or non-progressive. The students having temporary handicap would not be considered against the reserved scats for physically handicapped where the certificates are issued by any authority other than the Principal Medical Officer of Chandigarh and the candidate's turn comes for admission against reserve seat for physically handicapped.

medical Officer. Chandigarh and shall refer the candidate to the Principal mations from the P.M.C., Chandigarh.

(d) Reservation for children and grand child. n of Freedom Fighters

Two percent seats in each pool would be filled from amongst the children and grand children of Fredom Fighers. The wards of freedom fighter who have been sanction posion awarded 'Tamra patra' by the Government of India would be eligible for reservation under this category. In the case of such freedom fighter, it would be a necessary condition for them to obtain a certificate from the D.C. of the concerned district. Grand children means son's sons/daughters or daughter's sons/daughters.

(e) Reservation for Sportsmen/Sportswomen

Two per cent scate would be illed up with sportsmen/sportswomen to per guidelines annexed.

- 3. In order to give implementation to the above policy it is, however, larified as under :--
 - (a) the students belonging to above reserved category admitted on the basis of these morit in the general category shall not be accounted for the categories concerned.
 - (b) the students who apply in more than one reserved category will be considered in each reserved category in which he/she applies for admission, naturalising his/her inter-se equivally in each reserved category on the basis of merit in each category. In such cases, the student will get the benefit in one category of his/her choice, liewever, no further reservation shall be allowed within the reserved entegories.
 - (c) the student belonging to above category will also be considered in the general category according to his/her merit.
 - (d) all candidates sacking admission, except in the case of Chandigarh Medical College and Punjab Engineering College (where the existing practice shall continue). will furnish an undertaking as under alongwith his/her application form:

"I certify that I have no such physical handicap/disability which would hinder the persuit of studies in the courses in which I am seeking admission. If at a later stage it is found that I have a physically handicap/disability which hinders the pursuit of studies in the courses in which I am seeking admission, then my admission will be liable to be cancelled.

In case he/she has doubts whether the physical handicap/ disability is such as will hinder or not pursuit of studies in the courses in which he/she is seeking admission, he/she should appear before the Principal Medical Officer, General Hospital. Sector 16, Chandigarh to get the doubt cleared. On his/her admission, he/she will furnish a medical fitness certificate issued by the Principal Medical Officer. Chandigark to the effect that he/she is in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with efficient performance in his/her studies in the Institution and posses the standard of visual acquity with or without classes.

- (e) If the requisite number of students belonging to the category of defence/paramilitary personnel, Physically handicapped, freedom fighters are not available, the seats will be thrown open to the students of general category of the said pool.
- 4. There would be so reservation for any category other than the categories mentioned above in this letter. You are requested to incorporate the above provisions is the pro-pectus of your institution for admission in the ensuing academic sension 1993-94. In case of any doubt reference may please be made to Home Is partment for clarification and persued personally. This policy may be strictly adhered to and departure from this policy shall be viewed seriously.

Reservation Policy

Reservation for various categories of students in each pool shall be as under:-

I. Reservation for Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes, Union Territory Pool

- a) Scheduled Castes*
- b) Scheduled Tribes*

*As per Reservation Norms of Chandigarh Administration

If the total number of candidates are less than the reservation, then if required there will be an inter transfer of reservation seats between Chandigarh quota and Outstation quota. If SC/ST seats are still vacant after exhausting all SC/ST candidates, then they will be thrown open in the general pool on the last day of counselling schedule.

The students belonging to these communities shall be allowed a concession of 5% marks for admission to the course in which a certain percentage of minimum marks has been prescribed, by the regulation of the University/Board, to which the institution is affiliated.

II. Reservation for dependents of Defence / Paramilitary Personnel

There is a reservation of 5 % seats for these categories in each pool. The order of preference for admission under this category will be:

 Daughters/spouses of Defence personnel who are awardees of gallantry decorations or Paramvir/Mahavir/Vir Chakra in person or posthumously.

OR

Daughters/spouses of Defence personnel and paramilitary personnel like CRPF, BSF etc., who are killed or are totally incapacitated in action while in service and were wholly dependent on them.

- Daughters/spouses of Defence personnel and paramilitary personnel like CRPF, BSF etc., incapacitated while in service and were wholly dependent on them.
- Daughters/spouses of ex -servicemen (Defence and paramilitary personal like CRPF, BSF etc.) who are wholly dependent on them.
- Daughters/spouses of serving Defence personnel and Paramilitary personnel like CRPF, BSF etc., who are wholly dependent on them.

III. Concession to direct descendents of the Kargil martyrs upto Academic Year (2020-21):

The ward of martyrs/permanent disabled (upto 80% leading to incapacitation) of Kargil war who have a valid certificate from the Ministry of Defence to this effect and the same is entered in the Pension Book of the family.

- 1% or 1 seat in the Department and affiliated college except in partially financed/ Self financed course.
- Exemption in fee.
- · Exemption in hostel fee.

IV. Additional Seats for Cancer, AIDS and Thalassemia patients w.e.f. 2015-16.

- One additional seat each for the student suffering from Cancer/AIDS/Thalassemia has been allowed for admission in each course in the Panjab University Teaching Departments, Regional Centres and its affiliated Colleges subject to the condition that the candidate seeking admission under this category is otherwise eligible from all angles.
- The claimant candidate will have to submit a certificate as a proof from a National Medical Institute like PGI, AIIMS in support of her claim.

V. Additional Seats for Single Girl Child and One Girl Child out of only two girl children w.e.f. 2015-16.

- Two additional seats per unit per course subject to maximum limit of four(4) out of the two girl children from the session 2015-16 are created for admission to a given course in the Panjab University Teaching Departments, Regional Centres and its affiliated Colleges provided they are otherwise eligible from all angles. The additional seats will be only for those girl children who are either a single girl child of her parents or one amongst the only two girl children with no male child. The additional seats will be available to only one of the two girl children of a couple.
- An affidavit on a stamp paper worth Rs. 20/- duly attested by 1st class Magistrate, to be obtained from the parents of the girl children declaring therein that the benefit of this scheme is being claimed for only one girl child out of the two girl children and the parent shall not claim for the 2nd girl child elsewhere in the future. The specimen of the affidavit is enclosed.

VI. Reservation for Physically Challenged

3% seats in each pool would be filled from amongst the physically challenged candidates. The physically challenged student will furnish a medical certificate issued by the Principal Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon of Chandigarh or her concerned district, indicating percentage of disability, whether she is otherwise able to carry on the studies and perform the duties in the respective course, name of the disease causing handicap, whether handicap is temporary or permanent, whether handicap is progressive or nonprogressive. The students having temporary handicap would not be considered against the reserved seats for physically challenged. Where the certificates are issued by any authority other than the Principal

VII. Reservation for Children/ Grand Children of Freedom Fighters:

A certificate from the District Magistrate to this effect must be submitted by the candidate, Migration card alone is not enough.

IX. Concessions to the Wards of Kashmiri Migrants/Displaced persons

- 5% weightage will be given and the merit will be determined accordingly provided that the candidate fulfills the minimum prescribed qualifications.
- 5% increase intake subject to maximum of 3 seats (to be treated as additional seat(s) per course) at the entry point will be made in all courses at under graduate and post graduate level.
- Submission of a certificate to the effect that the applicant is a ward of Kashmiri Displaced person, issued by an Authorized Govt. Officer, is mandatory.

X. Reservation under the Sports Quota

• 2% of total number of seats in each course shall be filled up with sportswomen. These two percent seats shall be reserved in each branch of engineering/non-engineering courses in the institutions on the basis of total intake of each branch and fraction of 0.5 or above shall be rounded off to the next higher number, subject to amendments by the concerned department. This category shall not be divided into UT Pool/General Pool. The intermerit of the candidates seeking admission in any course in the reserved category of sports shall only be determined on the basis of their merit in sports as per grading criteria. In case of any of the seats in the sports category in any of the branches remains unfilled, the same shall be thrown open to the candidates belonging to general category.  - ✓ Category A is considered as higher category followed by B, C onwards.
 - ✓ Preference will be given to the candidate/s who have represented Panjab University, Chandigarh in A, B, C or D category.
 - ✓ In case of two or more candidate having equal position at equal level:
 - a) Position secured in an individual item shall be rated higher than position secured as a team member.
 - b) The eligibility of the candidate for participation in University Youth Festivals, in future, may also be considered.
 - Academic record will be considered in case of tie between two or more candidates.
- 4. In case of any ambiguity, the related certificates shall be verified from the Department of Youth Welfare, Panjab University through the concerned Chairperson/Principal/Head etc.
- 5. The candidate/s admitted on the basis of Youth Festival additional quota seats shall have to give an assurance to the university authorities that during the duration of the course, the candidate will participate in the activities associated with his/her item and will not create any kind of indiscipline. The admission committee will assess the participation of the candidate and in case the candidate does not fulfill the requirements, her admission may be cancelled. However, exemption may be given because of special reasons like sickness or any other unavoidable reason.
