- Encourage blended learning and the use of innovative pedagogical methodologies and ICT tools for effective student-centered learning and better classroom experience by familiarizing both the faculty and students with the various teaching and communication platforms.

- To encourage students and staff to engage themselves in research, innovation and patenting.

- To motivate staff to participate in Faculty Development Programs, Orientation Programs and Refresher Courses.

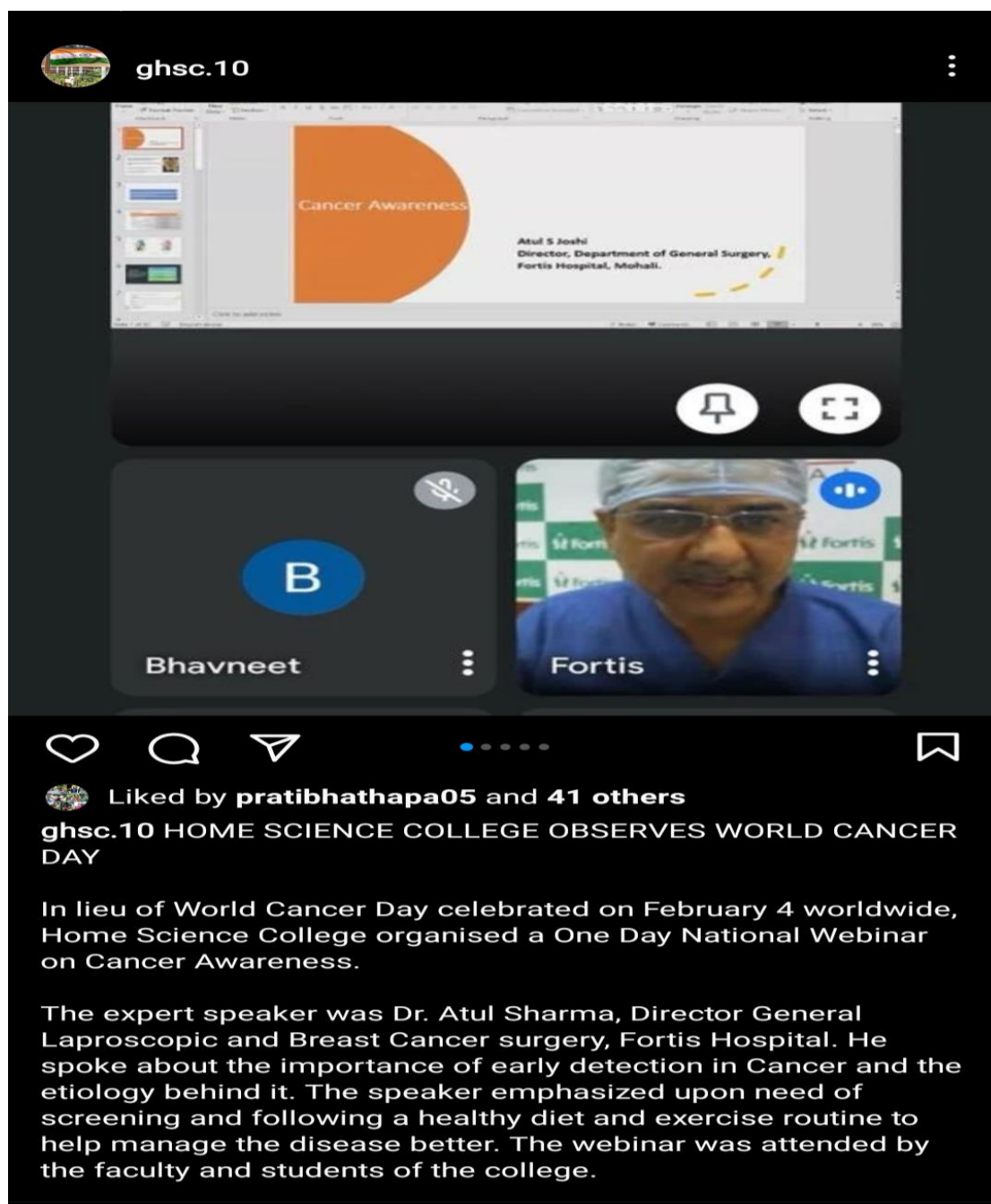

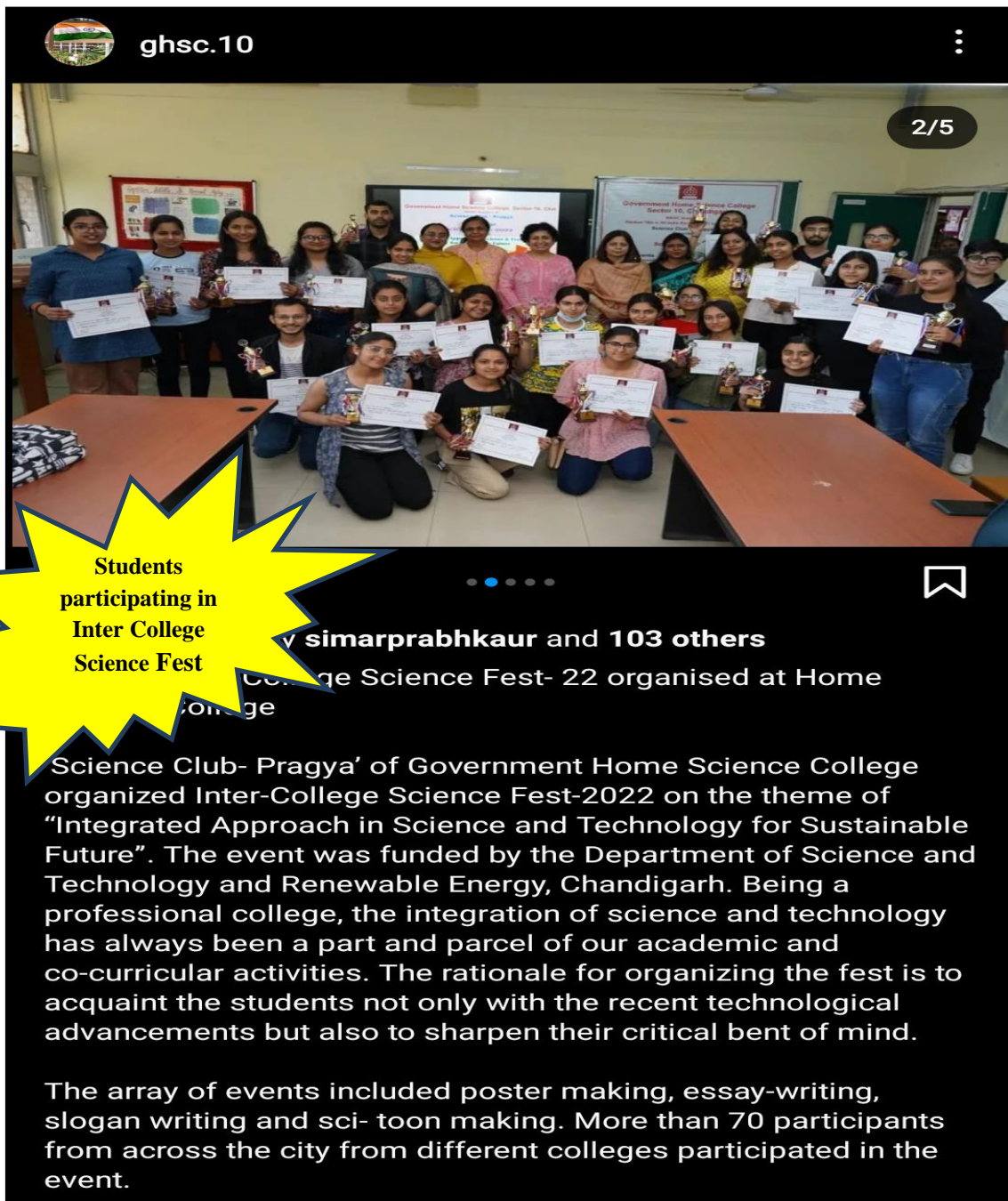

The array of events included poster making, essay-writing, slogan writing and sci- toon making. More than 70 participants from across the city from different colleges participated in the event.

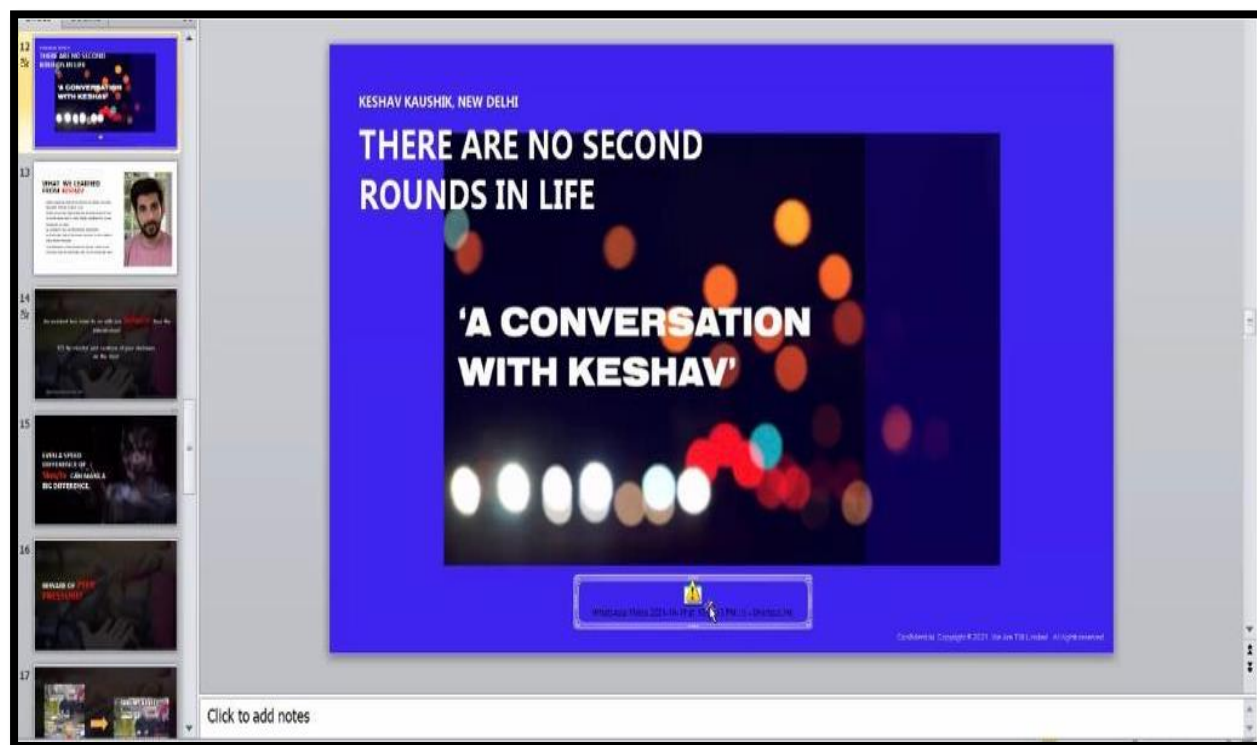

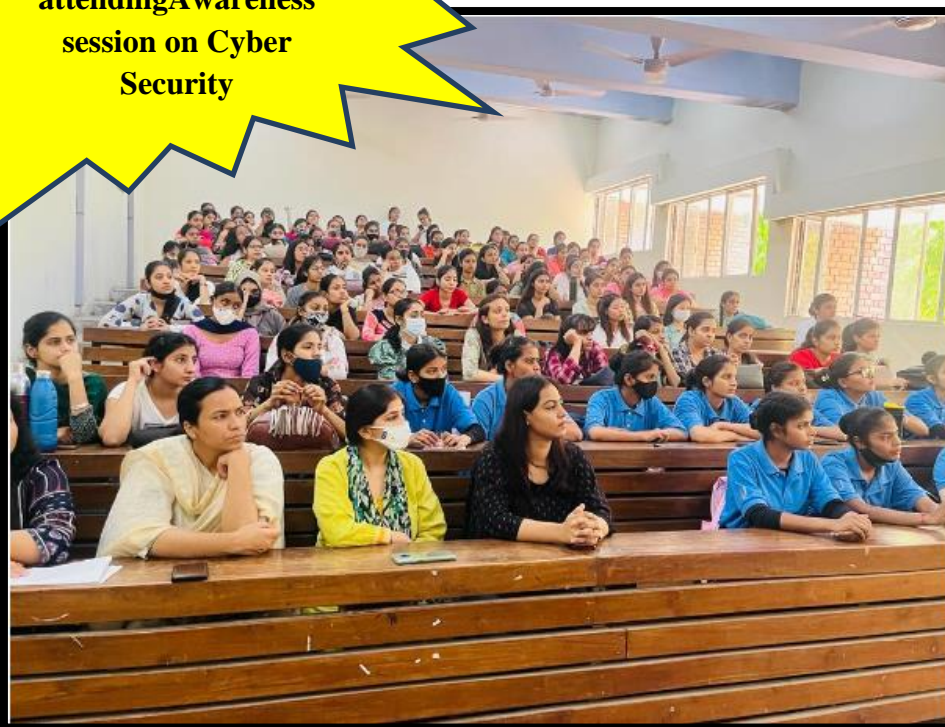

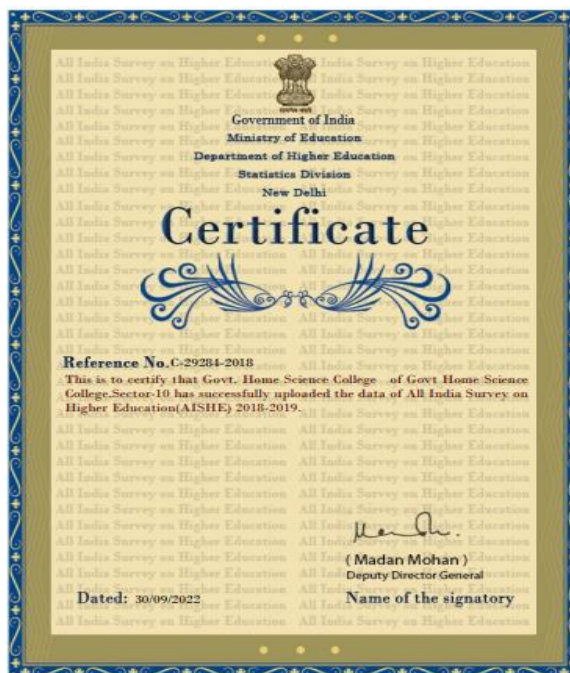
