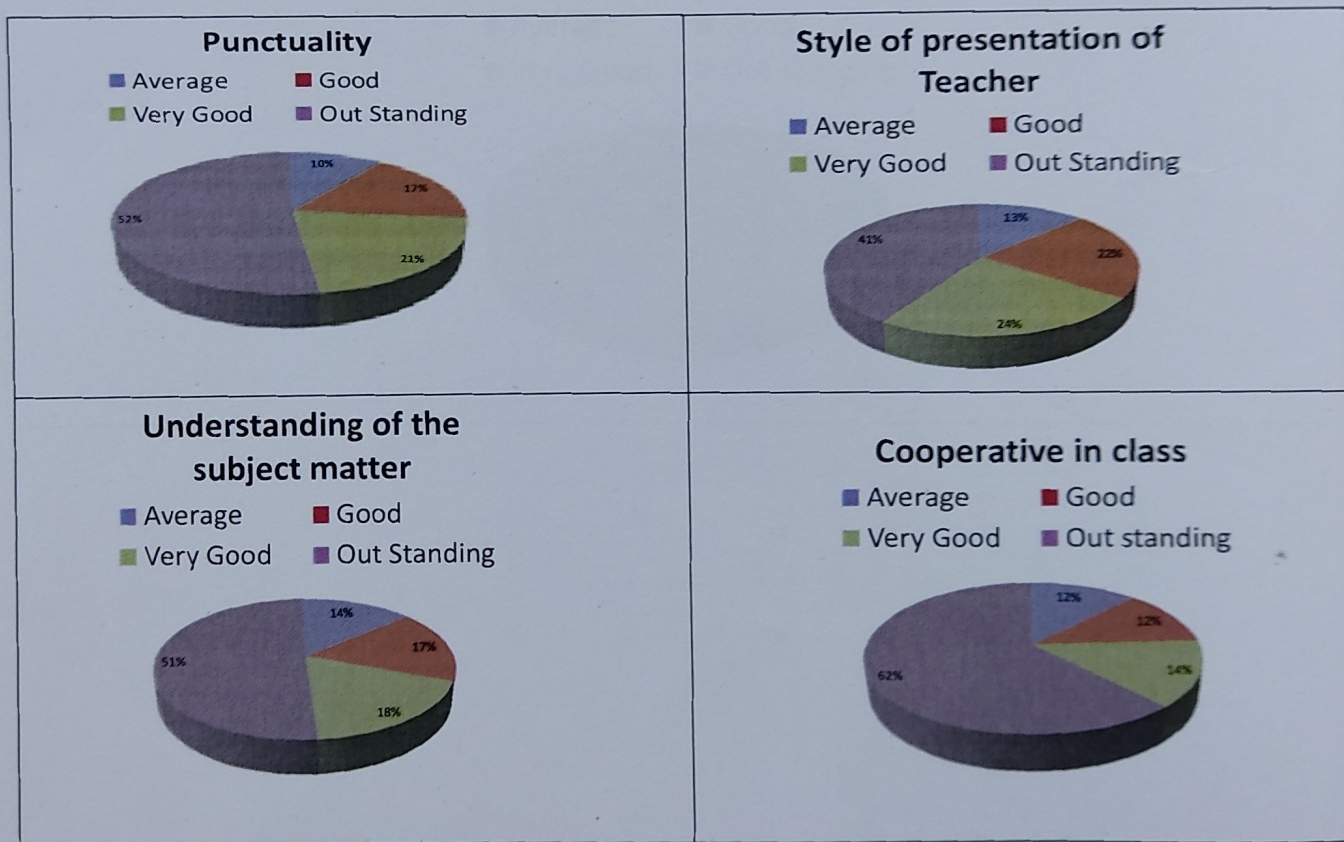


Feedback Analysis of 2017-18

Analysis of Feedback Collected from various stakeholders (Students, Teachers, Alumni, Parents And Employer) is as follows:

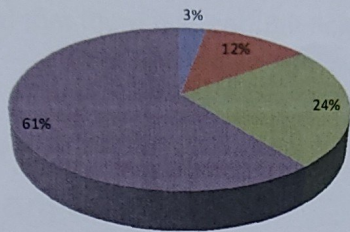
Students' Feedback Analysis

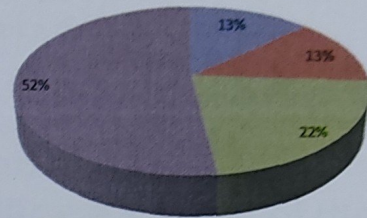
Makes Subject learning More Interesting

- Out standing



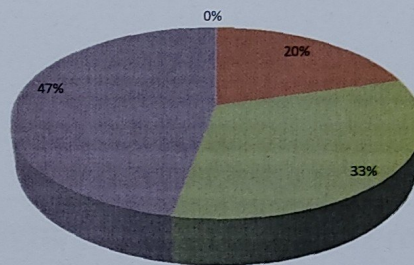
Interest generation by teachers

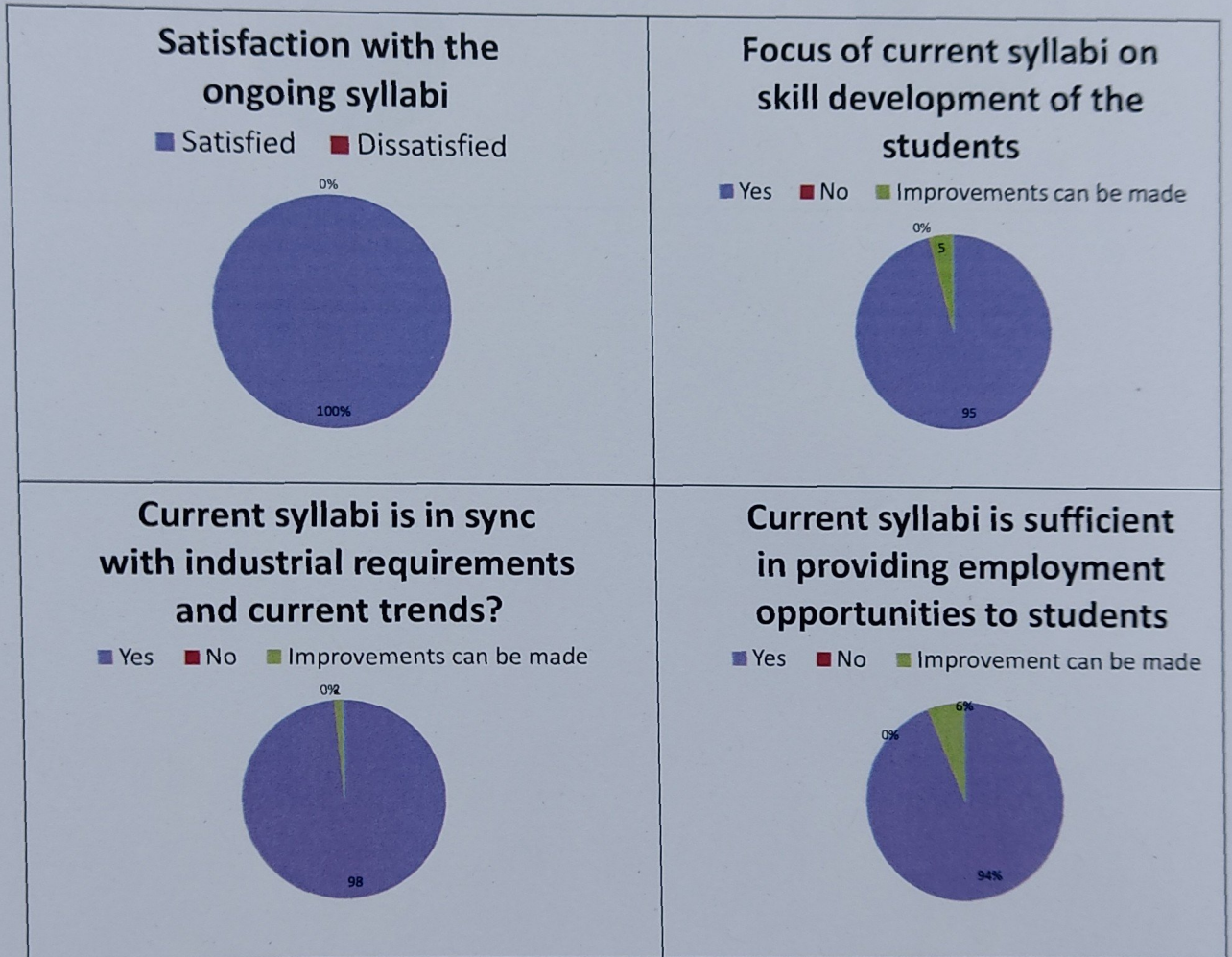
Overall Rating of the teacher

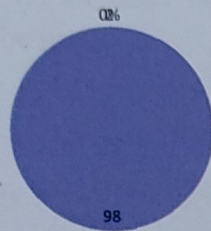
Teachers' Feedback Analysis

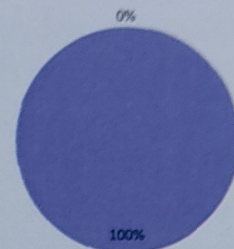
**Present infrastructure

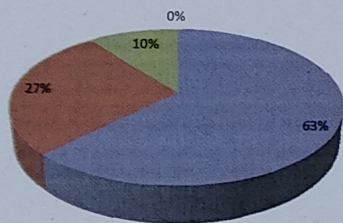


Alumni Feedback Analysis

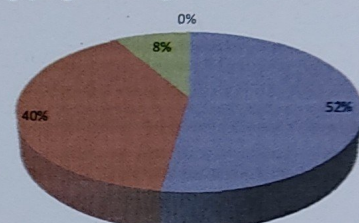
Syllabus is well structured and updated from time to time

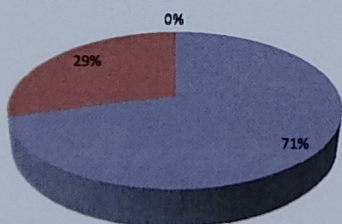
Course curriculum is in sync with employability and industry requirements

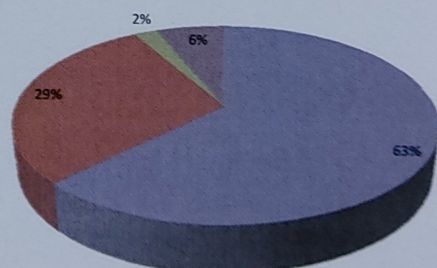
College organizes various academic and co-curricular activities for overall development of students

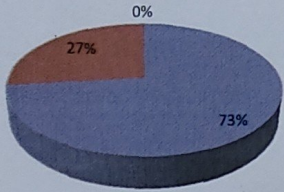
College have adequate infrastructure facilities

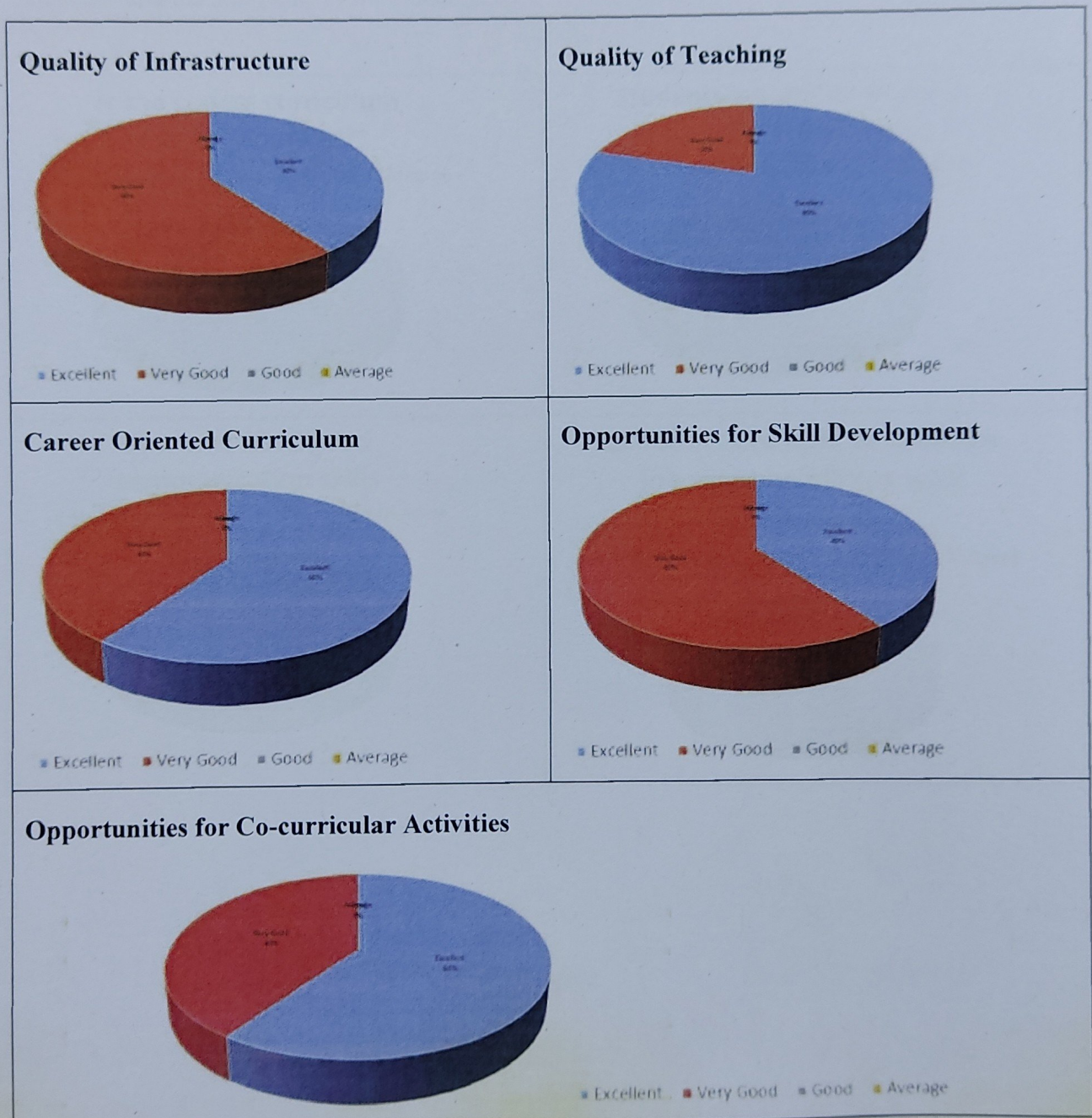
Do you feel proud to be associated with this college as an alumna?

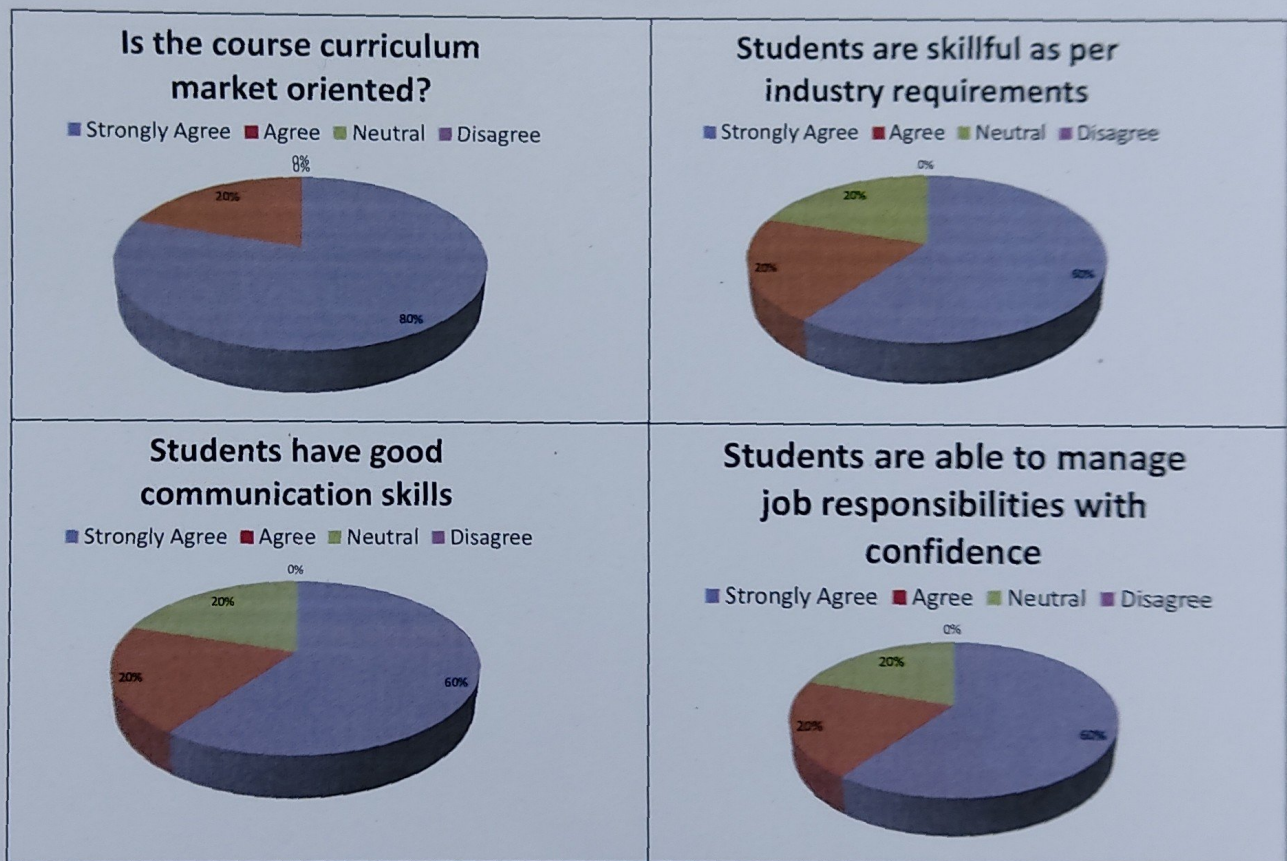
Parents' Feedback Analysis

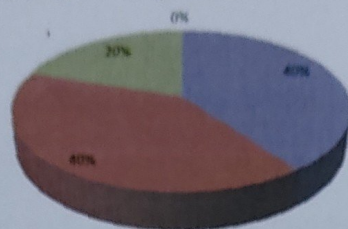
Employers' Feedback Analysis

Action Taken Report for Feedback of Session 2017-2018

Feedback was collected from various stakeholders. As per the suggestions given by them, following measures were taken:-

1. For the cleanliness of college campus and canteen-
 - The cleanliness committee was instructed to conduct regular cleanliness drives in the college.
 - Six dustbins (3 Green and 3 blue) were purchased for disposal of dry and wet waste. They were kept at different places in the college campus for waste collection. A workshop cum demonstration for students and staff was also organized on how to make compost at home, which helped in generating awareness regarding waste management
 - Canteen menu supervision, upkeep and maintenance committee was instructed to, regularly check the menu as well as hygiene facility of the canteen.
2. Free “English Communication Bridge Course” was organized in collaboration with Regional Centre for Entrepreneurship Development (RCED) as an initiative towards enhancement of Soft Skills and English Communication among students.
3. Various curricular and co-curricular activities and workshops were organized to make the subject/ learning more interesting as well as to give platform to budding designers.
 - Home Science Fest 2019 was held on March 08, 2019 on the theme 'Earn while you learn'. The different departments put up their stalls to exhibit their products and put them on sale where in the students applied their learning skills in practice.
 - Annual fashion show 'Aakriti' was held on March 29, 2019 at Tagore Theatre. It showcased the theme 'Khadi For Nation, Khadi For Fashion'.
 - Akshay Urja Diwas, and Van Mahoatsav were celebrated to generate awareness about environment and sustainability.
4. For the overall holistic development of students
 - Talent Hunt and Teej Day were celebrated collectively with great enthusiasm.
 - Various teams participated in Zonal Youth Festival held from 03.10.2018-06.10.2018. Students won prizes in poster making, mime, shabad singing, mimickery and various heritage competitions.

- The college organized Kathak Dance Workshop in collaboration with "Society for the Promotion of Indian Classical Music and Culture amongst Youth" (SPIC MACAY).
5. As part of providing employment opportunities and placement, students of the college participated in career awareness and career drive held at DAV College, sector 10, Chandigarh in collaboration with D.H.E and Employment Exchange and attended a motivational talk on "Entry as an Officer in Indian Air Force"
