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
Introduction

Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) resulting from evaluation of student's experience based on the facilities and support they receive in the college is very important. It is a valid and reliable tool to understand the key areas for future developments. Thus, it allows understanding the resources for areas that require greater attentions. Thus, it is a direct and useful indicator of the effectiveness of teaching-learning in the institution. The college encourages the students to take active participation in SSS.

Since students are the key stakeholders of feedback process of any educational institution, therefore, their satisfaction survey was conducted for the session 2022-23 i.e. total strength of 459 students. Out of these, 230 students i.e. 50% of the total strength responded with their feedbacks and gave their suggestions regarding teaching learning process, infrastructure and other parameters for the college and hostel. Their responses regarding the same were analysed and are listed in the report. The necessary actions were taken by the college.



1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class




Majority of the students i.e. 51 % have reported that almost 100 percent syllabus is covered in the class.

2. How well did the teachers prepare and communicate in the classes





Many of them reported thorough preparation ad communication of the teachers for respective class. More than half of the students reported that teachers prepare satisfactorily for the class.






More than 50 percent of the students reported that the curriculum is helpful in skill development and making them self reliant






Majority of the students described teaching approach to be very effective.

5. Fairness of internal evaluation process by the teacher




Approximately half of the students reported internal evaluation process to be always fair.

6. Is your performance in assignments and tasks discussed with you and necessary follow up taken with you and necessary follow up taken with you?





Majority of the students responded that performance in assignments was discussed every time with them by the teachers and necessary follow up is always taken.

7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.




Approximately half of the students reported that the institute takes active interest in promoting internships, placements, student exchange and field visits.






Majority of the students informed that the teaching and mentoring process in the institution facilitates cognitive, social and emotional growth



9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow by participating in extracurricular activities


Most of the students strongly agreed that institution provides them multiple opportunities to learn and grow by participating in extra-curricular activities.






Approximately half of the students agreed that teachers inform them about job opportunities in private and public sector.

11. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples, demonstrations, and applications




More than half of the students informed that the teachers illustrate the concepts through examples, demonstrations, and applications.

12. The teachers identify your strength and encourage you to use them in right way to make best use of them




Majority of the students agreed that the teachers identify their strengths and encourage them to use them in right way to make best use of them.

13. Teachers are able to identify your weakness and help you to overcome them




More than half of the students informed that teachers are able to identify their weaknesses and help to overcome them.

14. The institution makes an effort to engage students in monitoring, and organizing various curricular and co-curricular activities




Most of the students agreed that the institution offers enough opportunities to students in the monitoring and organizing various curricular and co-curricular activities.

15. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning, and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences moderately.




Most of the students replied that the the institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences moderately.

16. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work



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
17. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc. while teaching?



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
Majority of the students reported that 70-89 percent of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc.

18. The overall quality of teaching learning process in your institute is very good




Majority of the students strongly agreed that the overall quality of teaching-learning process in the institute is very good.

21. OBSERVATIONS / SUGGESTIONS OF STUDENTS REGARDING TEACHING –LEARNING

The institution has received positive feedback from many students who consider the quality of teaching and learning to be excellent. Students have provided valuable suggestions for enhancing the overall educational experience. Recommendations include the addition of more books and journals to the library, extending library hours to 24/7, providing digital access to books, improving furniture in classrooms and laboratories, and incorporating more ICT in teaching. To address these suggestions, the institution has taken decisive actions. The library has been expanded with the acquisition of various new journals and books. To give access to e-content, library blog, e book reader kindlle and new software has been added in library. Classroom and laboratory furniture has undergone repairs, and steps have been taken to integrate more technology into the teaching process. Additionally, the hostel facilities have seen improvements, with the inclusion of nutrient-enriched food options in the menu and the recent renovation of the hostel kitchen with modern modular facilities. These actions reflect the institution's commitment to continuously enhance the learning environment based on student input.
