The celebrations started from Aug .14, 2018 with an awareness generating walkathon in which about 300 students participated. Various inter-college competitions comprising of Poster Making, Short Film Making, Eco Friendly Rangoli , Declamation competition and Nukad Natak on "AKSHAY URJA APNAO ,PARIYAWARAN BACHAO " were organised in the entire time span . Students from 12 government and private colleges participated in the competitions with full zeal and favour and gave on another a tough competition. Grand finale of Akshay Urja Week celebrations were held in the college auditorium. Prizes were distribute by the chief guest Sh. B.L. SHARMA IAS, Education Secretary, to the winners for the various inter college competitions. The chief guest congratulated all the students and faculty members and advocated the importance of educated and enlighten man power as the greatest asset to the nation. He appreciated the efforts of the college in order to encourage the students to use renewable sources of energy.

 <u>Go green stall</u>:- HARITA –ENVIROMENT SOCIETY put up a stall sponsored by Deptt. Of Environment, Chd. UT. Grant of amounting rupees 25,500 was given to Harita Environment society for the various students activities to be done for GO GREEN STALL during Home science fest on 8th march, 2019. The detailed activities done by the students were like segregation of waste was demonstrated to the students in the botany lab and composting of green (kitchen) waste was practically done by the students through composting techniques which can further be used at their own home. They were taught , how to prepare herbal beauty products at home in small scale for personal use in day-to –day life in the chemistry lab , namely , Aloe vera serum , rose serum , makeup setting spray , astringent , face pack , orange srub , rose water , coffee scrub , skin toners , lip balm , etc .

Eco – holi colours were got prepared by the students in the botany lab, like , haldi chandan powder , marigold flower petals (FOR YELLOW COLOUR) , beetroot extracts (FOR RED COLOUR), red cabbage extracts (FOR PURPLE AND BLUE COLOUR) , dried henna powder (FOR GREEN COLOUR).

Students were taught how to grow MICROGREENS in earthen /ceramic trays.

Students were made aware air-purifier plants as per NASA and were also told to keep such plants in their hostel rooms and also use them as indoor plants at their homes. A no. of air purifier plants were made available to show it to the students and also the visitors during home science fest at GO GREEN STALL.

Students were taught to use vegetables colours instead of chemicals for block printing. So they did block printing on white pillow covers as an activity.

Some decorative items were also prepared by the students under the theme BEST OUT OF WASTE.

Students were encouraged to save energy by demonstrating the use of LED lights using model prepared by the students.

Promotional quiz was conducted where people were asked environment related questions, so as to spread awareness about the GO GREEN THEME.

Inter college face painting competition using co-friendly colours was also organised during the home science fest. About.10 teams participated in the vent from different institutions of Chandigarh and Mohali.
