It was apprised that a provision of Rs.1.00 crore has been made in the budget estimates for the year 2017-18 for the procurement of laptops to be distributed under the e-Sanatak Scheme amongst the Girls Students belonging to the Priority Households as determined under Section 10 of National Food Security Act, 2013 and as per the eligible Households identified by the Chandigarh Administration under the said Act and admitted in B.A./B.Sc./BCA/B.Sc. Home Science 1<sup>st</sup> year in the Govt. Colleges/Institutions of U.T., Chandigarh during the academic session 2017-18.

It was, further, apprised that the lists of Girls Students of B.A./B.Sc./BCA/B.Sc. Home Science 1<sup>st</sup> year of the academic session 2017-18 supplied by the Govt. Colleges/Institutions, U.T., Chandigarh for extending the benefit under the e-Sanatak Scheme does not have supporting with the proof of Priority Households. The Govt. Colleges/Institutions have mentioned the income of the parents of such girls students ranging between Rs.1.00 lac to Rs.3.00 lacs to determine

the eligibility of priority households. As per notification dated 13.5.2016 of the Department of Food and Supplies, Chandigarh Administration, the gross annual income limit of the parents of girls students was prescribed as Rs. 1.5 lacs from all sources for inclusion as priority households.

Accordingly, the matter was deliberated in view of the said notification issued by the Department of Food & Supplies and Consumer Affairs and Legal Metrology on 13.5.2016 and it was decided that the Department of Higher Education, Chandigarh Administration may draw up a format of undertaking regarding determination of eligibility as priority households to be submitted by the girls students for claiming the benefit under the e-Sanatak Scheme. Accordingly, the application format and undertaking have been devised as Annexure-I. The Education Secretary directed that Principal should ensure to furnish the list of eligible candidates within a week positively so as to enable the O/o DHE to initiate the process of procurement of laptops.
